### How to access the service



By calling one of our offices, customers can book a flight with us! Providing their frequent flyer account and flight numbers; the service is available daily, including holidays, from 5 am to 11 pm.

When to use the service? You can use the service if are traveling with hand luggage on flights departing:

- from any Americay airport with domestic destinations

The service is available from a maximum of 4 hours up to a minimum of 40 minutes before departure for domestic flights within the US or 50 minutes for international flights; you can extend the service to other passengers if they are included in your reservation.

### How to get your boarding pass

You can get your boarding card at the airport 30 minutes before departure for domestic flights within the continental US, 40 minutes before departure for international flights and 60 minutes before departure for intercontinental flights.

- At AmeriCay Eagle lounges
- At the exclusive check-in desks (Eagle members)
- At the Fast Check-in machines available at the main hub airports.



Your journey begins well before you get on the plane. That is why we provide you with all the information necessary to make your preparations easy. Check what documents you will need for your journey and find out our services for travellers who need full assistance on board and our special programme to overcome your fear of flying.

## Supply of personal information before the departure

**NEW** In order to enhance customs and borders protection system and simplify check-in and boarding procedures on the flights from/to the United States, US authorities ask each passenger to supply personal information at the time of booking/issue of the ticket or **at least 72 hours** before your flight's scheduled departure: given names (as they appear on the passport), date of birth, gender and redress number, if available (it's a code given to certain passengers whose names were added to the No-Fly list by mistake). Failure to provide your personal information may result in denial of transport or denial of authority to enter the boarding area.

## Minors

Children before their twelfth birthday are entitled to several **fare discounts** and a special assistance. At JFK airport you will find an 'AmeriCay' Lounge (Terminal 2, opening hours 05:30-24:00) equipped with a nursery with kitchenette, utensils and baby-care items.

On intercontinental flights, you will find cots\*. When booking flights for children between 2 and 11 (before the 12th birthday), you can ask for a 'children's meal' containing a selection of things which most children like. An infant who has not reached his or her 2nd birthday may not occupy a seat and must be accompanied by either a parent, or an adult over 18 (the parent can be under 18, as long as he or she has legal responsibility for the child). It must be pointed out in any case on the accompanying adult's reservation.



\* Some aircraft have cots for use on board, to be handed back to the cabin staff at the end of the flight. Our 'cot-on-board' service should be booked when you get your ticket. If this service should not be available, you can take your own cot into the cabin, making sure first that it fits in the space available, otherwise it will have to be placed in the baggage hold.

## Traveller's Care

AmeriCay has a dedicated program of special assistance, as per EC 1107/06 regulation, for persons with reduced motion or sensorial capacities, **that must be requested at booking time.** It is therefore important always to **ask for confirmation from your travel agent or the call centre** about service availability by requesting it specifically when booking. It is recommended to request assistance **at least 48 hours before the published flight departure time.**

### Wheelchair and stretcher onboard

You can take your own wheelchair with you for free, whether it be folding or electric, that will be registered as baggage in hold at check-in. Please remember that deadline time-limit to show up at check-in is:

- 60' before departure for US domestic flights
- 90' for international flights
- 120' for intercontinental flights

Otherwise you may book different options wheelchair:

- until the aircraft staircase
- until the aircraft cabin entrance, avoiding climbing stairs
- until your seat onboard

If you need to travel lying down, you may request the stretcher service when booking.

### Guide dogs



Guide dogs that travel with persons who can't see nor hear are put in hold in a dedicated kennel or in cabin with muzzle and leash, if space is available.

These pets travel for free and with no weight limits. When booking the flight, availability for the dog must be requested at that time. The dog owner must supply the necessary travel equipment (muzzle, leash and/or kennel).

Oxygen therapy

Passengers that have heart, lung or breathing problems may book the oxygen service, to avoid possible disorders caused by in-cabin pressure when flying at high altitude.

### Onboard escort for dependent travellers

All passengers who are not self-sufficient, blind or deaf or that need wheelchair or stretcher, must have an escort who can give them all necessary assistance during travel at any time.

## Our Fleet



Our fleet consists of aircraft well-suited for anything from short to long haul flights. Our smallest aircraft, the Embraer Regional Jet 145, capable of carrying 50 passengers, with a range of 3706km, is perfect for our short-haul flights, such as our main base, Las Vegas, to the beautiful city of Los Angeles.

AmeriCay also has another Embraer, the advanced Embraer 170. This quick, efficient aircraft is capable of carrying up to 89 passengers and flying 3889 kilometers non-stop. This fast, quiet jet services our short and mid-haul flights, an excellent aircraft for our flights. AmeriCay has recently recently bought a brand new Boeing 737-800. Seating up to 189 passengers, this mid-to-long-haul aircraft services our new, expansive, and popular routes, such as Las Vegas to sunny Miami, FL.



For our third anniversary, July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010, we recently converted a few of our 757-200s to our AmeriCay fleet. Carrying up to 234 passengers, with a range of 7222 kilometers, the Boeing 757-



200 is perfect for the longest of our flights, such as Las Vegas to tropical Honolulu. Each of the aircraft in AmeriCay's fleet are refurbished just for AmeriCay, delivering 8.1" in-screen seats, over 100 channels of XM Satellite

Radio™, a channel to listen to live ATC, and a flight crew who's only goal is to content the passengers.

## Our hubs

**Las Vegas**, the most populated city in Nevada, an international resort for gambling, fine dining, and shopping, is an excellent hub. McCarran International Airport ranks 15<sup>th</sup> in the world for passenger traffic, with "44,074,707" passengers being flown in and out in 2008. This airport is nicely situated, in the middle of beautiful, seemingly endless deserts, right next to the Metropolitan area of Las Vegas.



**John F. Kennedy** International airport is situated right between the Atlantic Ocean and the



New York City Metropolitan area. Being the United State's largest international passenger gateway, this beautiful airport serves as a wonderful hub that connects us not only to the rest of the United States, but to Europe and the Caribbean as well.

## VAFS:

Would you like a simple and easy way to know which flights are service by AmeriCay? It's simple! All of our AmeriCay flights begin with a "1" and end with an "A" (1xxxA, x representing any number). As an example, route 1011A represents our flight from Miami to our base of New York City. Want to find an AmeriCay flight that leads to the tropics? These flights will begin with "11", and end with an "A" (11xxA, x representing any number). For example, CAY1100A services Cancun from New York City.

## VATSIM:

AmeriCay strongly recommends the use of VATSIM. This wonderful utility connects pilots from all over the globe, allowing for an ultra-real experience. Trained professionals provide extremely realistic ATC, following practically all real-world procedures. VATSIM truly enhances the flight-sim experience in a way that will make you want to always be in the skies. VATSIM is also what allows us to have our AmeriCay events, the "*Stars and Stripes*" Events, hosted one out of three Fridays, at least once a month. When communicating with ATC, AmeriCay uses "Cayman" as its callsign. However, feel free to use "AmeriCay" as your callsign. In your remarks, make sure to include your name (ex: Captain P. Bastings), the registration of your plane (ex. N145KX), a link to the airline ([www.flycay.com](http://www.flycay.com)), the airline name (FlyCay or Cayman Airways Virtual), the division (AmeriCay), and possibly our brand-new AmeriCay website, [www.americayva.com](http://www.americayva.com).
