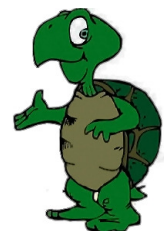

What is CayConnect?

CayConnect is a brand new division within the Cayman Virtual Corporation. We specialize in short to medium haul operation services utilizing a fleet of Embraers and the Boeing 737-700 for now. We have three unique branches within this division at this time, one located in the United States; the second is based in Europe and the last based in the Eastern Caribbean!

This division is a completely unique entity and in no way is related to our Cayman Airways division. We founded this division on July the 6th 2009 in an effort to provide our existing pilots with a larger route network to enjoy and experience, but also to attract new potential pilots who are primarily based in either Europe, North America or the Eastern Caribbean exclusively. When you join us you are becoming a part of the Cayman Virtual Corporation and you will have full freedom to fly in any one of our unique divisions!

Beginning July 6 2009, due to the high demand in business, regional commuter routes, the Cayman Virtual Corporation will expand their network of operations to include a regional division. Cay Connection will employ the use of three trusted regional aircraft the Embraer 145 and 170 and B737 respectively. Cay Connect will service areas covered by regional feeder routes in Europe, the Caribbean and the North America. This will give our pilot base a larger route network to choose from as well as attract newer pilots that felt more comfortable near their home area. Pilots will not be limited to just flying the Cay Connection regional routes but also will be able to fly all Cayman Airways Virtual routes, all FlyCay routes, all Cay Cargo routes and finally all Cay Connect routes.

AmeriCay is our brand new regional operations branch based in North America. Similar to our EuroCay division we offer exclusive flights to a finite amount of destinations, however, we have two bases of operations in the United States, one can be found in our existing hub of New York, our second can be found further west in Las Vegas. All of our flights are serviced by Embraers, both the ERJ145 and the EMB170, for now, these aircraft are the ideal aircraft for these flights we have found and are a very welcome addition to our fleet. We have major plans for expansion in the future for AmeriCay, all expansions are done as realistically as possible, just like our Cayman Virtual counterpart, everything we do, we do well.

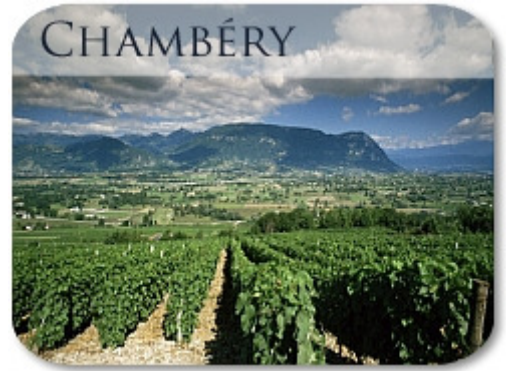

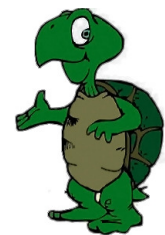

Plans for the future?

We have huge plans for the CayConnect division in the future. VAFS:

To identify Cay Connect flights in VAFS simply find flights that end in “A” for **AmeriCay** and “E” for **EuroCay**. For example, **CAY123E** would identify that particular flight as a **EuroCay** flight.

VATSIM:

Flying in the VATSIM environment for the regional Cay Connection flights is nearly identical to flying on VATSIM for any of the other Cayman Airways Virtual divisions with the exception of the flight plan remarks and call sign. When flying for either EuroCay or AmeriCay, we ask that you enter the following remarks in the flight plan form:

AmeriCay:

Call Sign= AmeriCay // Cayman Virtual// www.flycay.com / CayConnect.php

EuroCay:

Call Sign=EuroCay//Cayman Virtual// www.flycay.com / CayConnect.php

When communicating on frequency in VATSIM, please use the call sign “AmeriCay or EuroCay” as in:

“Boston Center,. AmeriCay 123 is with you at FL340”
