

## Cayman Airways Virtual | Conduct Policy

Cayman Airways Virtual offers their full range of services to all pilots subject to the pilot's acceptance of our conduct policy

### Use of the Cayman Airways Virtual Website

- Persons making a submission to join Cayman Airways Virtual are referred to as **Pilots or Captains**.
- Whilst using the Cayman Airways Virtual Website your contribution in our forums and general operations are subject to monitoring and offending posts are liable to be removed, without notice, by authorized Cayman Airways Virtual personnel.

### Contacting Cayman Airways Virtual Staff

- It is required that you identify yourself by the name that you supplied with your application that was mailed to you when your application was accepted.
- All pilots or even visitors are more than welcome to use the Contact Form to contact our staff through the main website.
- Comments of a derogatory nature, which are deemed offensive to Cayman Airways Virtual staff, will result in dismissal **without notice**.

### Online Conduct

- Pilots are reminded when using online services that you are a representative of Cayman Airways Virtual when using the **CAY** callsign.
- Pilots are to exercise good manners and not to engage in arguments over the networks.
- If Cayman Airways Virtual receives communication from networks about the conduct of any pilot, are liable to be dismissed **without notice**.

### Applications Information

- Providing false information on the membership application is **prohibited**.

- Should a pilot's identity fall into question at any time then we reserve the right to make our own checks to establish that pilot's true identity.
- Pilots who are found to have supplied incorrect information in order to gain admission are liable to be dismissed **without notice**.

## Use of the Cayman Airways Virtual Forum

When logging onto the Cayman Airways Virtual forum, you are subject to a user agreement for the said Forum.

- Pilots are reminded that foul and obscene language is **not tolerated** in any way, and pilots are not to engage in offensive slanging matches.
- Pilots who are unable to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner, should not post items on the forum.

The following debates or posts are considered **NOT** acceptable on the Cayman Airways Virtual Forum.

1. Offensive Language directed at staff or other pilots.
2. Pornographic links or material.
3. Advertising of other Virtual Airlines (unless authorized by Board members). This does include pilot's forum signatures and links.
4. Any debates or remarks which may offend International pilots regarding religious issues and local customs.
5. References to Links for Illegal Software.
6. Posts that are considered as non-contributory to the general well being and morale of the Virtual Airline.
7. Any posts that are of a political nature.
8. Member's profiles will not be used for non-flight simulation messages including jokes with sexual content or overtones.
